CITI Training Guidance:

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FAQs

1. What is CITI Program?

CITI Program is the leading provider of research ethics, compliance, and professional development education.

2. Who needs CITI training?

All members of the research team involved in the design, conduct, or reporting of the research must complete training. External study team members engaged in research activities including contact or communication with participants, access to identifiable data or specimens, or involved in the consent process must affiliate with UCF in CITI and complete the appropriate UCF CITI training. Members of the research team who have not completed human research protections training may not take part in aspects of the research that involve human subjects.

3. What are the CITI training requirements for the different types of IRB review?

Investigators and staff conducting social/behavioral/education research should complete **Human Subjects Research Group 2 Social/Behavioral Research** Investigators and Key Personnel.

Investigators and staff conducting biomedical research must complete **Human Subjects Research-Group 1 Biomedical Research Investigators and Key Personnel.**

Not Human Subjects Research- Researchers on studies that are Not Human Subjects Research are not required to complete CITI Humans Subjects Research training. This includes the PI, Faculty Advisor, co-investigators, and research assistants.

Exempt Studies- All researchers on exempt studies, UCF and external collaborators, that are considered engaged in the research must complete the UCF required CITI Human Subjects Research course. Uploading a CITI course completed at a separate university is not sufficient. **NOTE** - There may be instances where the study will go under dual review, where both IRBs will review the study. In these cases, there is a potential the IRB will accept training from another institution. This will be handled on a case by case basis.

Expedited and Convened Board Studies- All researchers on expedited studies, UCF and external collaborators, that are considered engaged in the research must complete the UCF required CITI Human Subjects Research course. Uploading a CITI course completed at a separate university is not sufficient.

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External IRB Studies- Studies where the UCF IRB is not the IRB of record (also known as a "Rely-Upon") will be handled on a case by case basis. If the IRB of record requires the UCF IRB to oversee training, the UCF IRB will require our CITI course.

4. Do faculty advisors need to have UCF CITI training?

Faculty advisors are ALWAYS required to have CITI training, unless the study is deemed Not Human Subjects Research or when an external IRB will act as the IRB of record for the study ("Rely-Upon") and the external IRB requires the faculty advisor to complete training. If the Rely-Upon agreement asks for the UCF IRB to oversee training, the UCF CITI completion is required.

5. What if I am working on a Department of the Navy (DON) study?

Department of the Navy (DON) must affiliate with DON in the CITI site and complete DON-Supported Extramural Performers in addition to the UCF Human Subjects Research course.

6. What if I am working on a Veterans Administration (VA)study?

The UCF IRB will accept the completion report for VA researchers when they are external collaborators and not require the collaborators to complete the UCF CITI course. UCF researchers on a VA study are additionally required to complete UCF required CITI Human Subjects Research.

7. Should I take additional CITI modules?

You are welcome to take any of the modules available to you, but for most studies, only the Group 1 or Group 2 Human Subject Research module is required prior to IRB approval. Additional CITI modules may be required to meet the needs of other compliance programs and/or funding agencies like Conflict of Interest, Good Clinical Practices, Responsible Conduct of Research, and Department of Navy.

8. How long does CITI training last?

Training is valid for a three-year period, after which time the training must be repeated as refresher course. Refresher courses can be retaken up to three times after which the full course must be completed again

9. Do I need to attach my course completion report to my IRB application?

UCF students and staff do not need to attach Human Subjects completion reports as these transfer directly from CITI to Huron IRB. If you have an external study team member, ask them for a copy of their completion report to upload to the IRB application.

If your study requires Department of Navy CITI training, upload the DON completion report for each study team member.

10. What if my completed courses don't display up in my CITI account or if my course completion doesn't show up in Huron IRB?

Contact CITI directly if your previously completed courses do not display in CITI. It is possible that they will need to merge accounts. If your course completion report doesn't show up in Huron IRB, check to see that your primary email address in CITI matches what is listed in Huron.

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


