

Free and Practical Cyber Security Expo Includes Tracks for Researchers

October 21, 2020 –October is National Cyber Security Awareness Month (NCSAM), and throughout the month, UCF InfoSec will be sharing security information and hosting events to help you and UCF stay secure from cybersecurity threats. Cyber threats are more prevalent and more serious than ever before. We must always be vigilant and through these efforts stay well informed.

In celebration of NCSAM, on Oct. 30th UCF InfoSec will be hosting the annual cybersecurity expo – PegaSec. This year's PegaSec Expo will be virtual and will feature cybersecurity content tailored for members of the UCF community. The Expo will also include sessions geared towards research. Sessions that may be of particular interest to researchers include:

- “Examining the Cyber Behaviors of Temporary Work-from-Home Employees” – ongoing research looking at how employees have altered their home environments to work securely and how they’re dealing with the stress of this.
- “Federal Cyber Requirements in Research Contracts” – the federal cyber requirements for research, in particular Controlled Unclassified Information.
- “Phishing Derby Review” – the results of a study conducted between researchers and InfoSec at UCF in which participants were challenged to identify phishing emails.
